<p>Summary of Program: The 1,000 in 1,000 program moves families out of poverty by helping them build 10 Pivotal Assets that have been statistically shown to dramatically increase the probability that families will be able to move from poverty to self-sufficiency. Each family has 1,000 days to complete their work (approximately 3 years).</p> <p>Program Overall Status: The program is on status to meet all objectives during the contract period. We have completed 120 of the 125 assessments for the contract period ending 9/30/16. We have 56 families enrolled in 1000 in 1000 who live in the Jax Journey zip codes in subsidized housing of the 60 families for the contract period ending 9/30/16.</p>
