Notice is hereby given that a team from the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation, Inc., will conduct an electronic assessment on the City of Jacksonville's **Office of Inspector General (OIG)** *Friday, July 24, 2020*, to evaluate the OIG for compliance with professionally recognized best business practices and standards, as mandated in *The Florida Inspectors General Standards Manual*.

The purpose of the assessment is to review policies and procedures, review operations, and interview OIG staff to determine compliance with all standards required for initial accreditation. Once the assessors complete the review, they report back to the full Commission, which will then decide if the OIG will receive accredited status.
